Valovanje v skulpturi

Waves in Sculpture

Danes so teoretične razprave o sodobnem kiparstvu in njegove analize na Slovenskem pogosto vezane na razmišljjanja o razstavnih postavitvah. Prav razstave so namreč tisti dogodki, na katerih se skulpture prostorsko vizualno udejanjijo, kar dokazujejo predvsem kiparska dela, ki so oblikovana in izpeljana z mislijo na določen razstavni prostor ter izbrano razstavno tematiko. S pomočjo razstavnih dogodkov in avtorskih postavitev principov se odpirajo mnoga strokovna vprašanja, vezana na sodobne kiparske prakse. Mestna galerija Ljubljana (MGML) aktivno pripravlja razstave in strokovno-teoretično sledi ustvarjalnemu dogajanju na področju kiparstva na Slovenskem. V zadnjih letih je pripravila naslednje razstavne prezentacije sodobnega kiparstva: leta 2012 razstavo z naslovom *Pot skozi skulpturo*, leta 2014 razstavo *Raztezanje kiparskih struktur* in tokrat, leta 2016, še kiparsko razstavo *Valovanje v skulpturah*. Na teh razstavah se je predstavilo sedemindvajset uveljavljenih in avtorsko prepoznavnih akademskih kipark in kiparjev. Izbrani umetniki tako kot razstave same dokazujojo, da je kiparsko ustvarjanje pri nas zelo močno, dinamično in ustvarjalno poglobljeno ter da operira s prepoznavnim likovnim jezikom, ki je tehnično, materialno, izraznostno in vsebinsko-motivno pregleden, za gledalce privlačen in vizualno ter pripovedno berljiv. Novi kiparski dosežki so postavljeni v odnose z razstavnimi prostori, a so predvsem materialno-časovne modulacije, ki implicirajo variabilnost materije in s tem forme, kot težnje po nenehnem gibanju, oziroma v našem primeru težnje po učinku podobe valovanja. Valoviti lahko pomeni različna razmerja med napeti – zrahljati, skrčiti – sprostiti, oviti – razviti, nazadovati – napredovati, raztegniti – omejiti, razmehčati – odreti. Kiparski organizem se torej lahko definira s svojo sposobnostjo, da lastne delce pregiba oziroma, da valovi v materialno razgrinjajočo se ter v vizualno urejeno podobo.

Sarival Sosič

Current theoretical discussions and analyses of contemporary sculpture in Slovenia are often associated with reflections on exhibition installations. And rightfully so, given that exhibitions are events at which sculptures become spatially and visually enacted as demonstrated, above all, by sculpture pieces designed and executed with a certain exhibition space and selected exhibition theme in mind. Exhibition events and authorial principles of installation give rise to new professional questions regarding contemporary sculpture practices. The City Art Gallery of Ljubljana (MGML) organises exhibitions and keeps abreast of creative trends in Slovenian sculpture in both professional and theoretical terms. Over the recent years it has organised the following exhibition presentations of contemporary sculpture: the exhibition *Pot skozi skulpturo* (*Paths through Sculpture*) in 2012, the exhibition *Raztezanje kiparskih struktur* (*Expanding Sculptural Structures*) in 2014, and for 2016 the exhibition *Valovanje v skulpturah* (*Waves in Sculpture*). The aforementioned exhibitions have featured twenty-seven accomplished and renowned academic sculptors. The selected artists, as the exhibitions themselves, have demonstrated that Slovenian sculpture is a strong, dynamic and highly engaging art form operating with a distinct artistic language that is technically, materially, expressively and motivically clear, attractive as well as visually and narratively legible. Although new accomplishments in sculpture are placed into relationships with exhibition spaces, they mainly serve as material-temporal modulations constraining the variability of material and hence form as a tendency towards constant movement or, in our case, a tendency towards creating an image of waving. Waving can denote different relationships between tighten-loosen, shrink-expand, fold-unfold, evolve-devolve, stretch-contract, soften-harden. The organism of sculpture can thus be defined on the basis of its ability to bend its own particles or rather to wave itself into a materially manifested and visually arranged image.
