

SVET, KOT GA VIDI THE WORLD AS SEEN BY

STANE JAGODIČ

Mestna galerija Ljubljana

The world as seen by Jagodič is full of contradictions. The artist's works form a rich visual lexicon of numerous, even extreme, social conditions and address themes such as ecology, social justice, solidarity, anti--militarism, progress and the search for a balance between them. They are full of satire, irony, paradox, humour, but also poetry and emotion, which makes them at once a rebellion against the follies of humanity and a manifesto of life. In them, Jagodič often reaches below the surface of the visible, into the entrails of nature, flirting with the world of science, cybernetics, robotics, the virtual, digital technology and projections of the future. After six decades of creative endeavour, Jagodič continues to (re)pose numerous questions about the times we live in. His works encompass human history and contemporary life as well as numerous artistic transformations, movements and reflections of the 20th century, especially the historical avant-garde of the 20th century. As an artist, he can be recognised as a futurist, surrealist, Dadaist, constructivist, magical realist, radical expressionist, brutal realist, conceptualist and, above all, as a humanist who at the same time stands out from all canons of reference.

Stane Jagodič belongs to Slovenia's more prominent contemporary visual artists committed to socially engaged art, produced primarily through the investigative endeavour and intermedia fusion of various experimental art practices. The exhibition highlights the part of his practice in which his artistic statements are expressed most directly or expressively. Although his work consistently crosses the boundaries of different media (from painting, drawing and collage to objects, montages, assemblages, installations in public space, etc.), his social criticique is most strongly evident in the expanded field that combines photography (from photomontages to X-ray collages / X-ray art), printmaking (from screenprints to spraygrams) and drawing (from caricature to visual and concrete poetry). Within this fusion, Jagodič most strongly utilises processuality as an important form of artistic statement, expanding his works from the point of objects into the zone of concepts and holistic artworks, sometimes also with an immersive effect.

Stane Jagodič held his first overview exhibition in 1975 at the City Art Gallery Ljubljana. Fifty years later, his work returns to the gallery, not as a continuation, but as an attempt at a new reading of his oeuvre, presented to the public on this scale for the first time. The exhibition spans the entire period of his practice, with particular emphasis on the 1970s and 1980s, his most formative years. Alongside documentary material, it also presents a selection of objects, performances and scenographies that played a key role within this framework.

Stane Jagodič

He graduated from the Academy of Fine Arts in Ljubljana in 1970. He was the founder and director of the Junij Group (1970–1985), an international art movement, as well as the creator of the Junij International Art Collection and the initiator and director of the Slovenian Triennial of Satire and Humour Aritas-satirA (1995–2001). He has held more than fifty solo exhibitions and has participated in numerous group shows at home and abroad. His works are included in both public and private collections. In 1979, he received the Prešeren Fund Award for his work. He lives and works in Ljubljana.
